

Piedmont Bend Recreation Association Rules and Regulations

All rules and regulations posted below are subject to change without notice.

In addition to the rules posted at the pool, by accepting membership, adults, including their guests, and children alike – are required to abide by the following rules to ensure the safety of everyone that will be enjoying our pool this season. Nothing is more important than our patrons' safety – our members or our guests. Failure to follow these rules may result in a revocation of pool membership.

Membership of Piedmont Bend Recreation Association is limited to all members of **one** household living under the same roof. Sharing/splitting of membership is strictly prohibited.

General Guidelines

HOURS OF OPERATION – The facilities are open to members and their guests according to the following schedule:

Monday – Thursday	10:00 am – 10:00 pm
Friday	10:00 am – 11:00 pm
Saturday	10:00 am – 11:00 pm
Sunday	10:00 am – 10:00 pm

This schedule may be modified as needed by the PBRA Executive Board prescribed for tennis, swimming, and other special functions.

PARKING – Parking is allowed in designated areas only during normal hours of operation. Parking is **PROHIBITED** on the street in front of the pool and tennis court area. Cars left after hours will be subject to towing.

PLAYGROUND AREA – Children must be supervised by a parent or guardian 16 or older.

ACCESS CARDS/TENNIS COURT KEYCODE – One key card is supplied to members as part of the registration fee. A second key will be issues, upon request; at any time during the current year of membership is good standing with verification of the original key fob issued to the member.

Swimming Rules and Regulations

POOL CLOSINGS

It may be necessary on occasion to close the pool for unexpected maintenance or other reasons deemed necessary by the pool maintenance company or the Executive Board. See pool schedule for other closing times.

GUESTS

A PBRA member must accompany guests at **ALL** times. Guests fees are \$5.00 for the first guest and \$2.00 for each additional guest thereafter. Residents of Piedmont Bend subdivision must pay membership fees to access and use the pool and related facilities as they cannot be a guest per the bylaws. **Guests of anyone 16 years or younger are NOT permitted.**

FOOD AND BEVERAGES

The consumption of food and beverages within the pool enclosure is permitted with the following stipulations:

- **NO GLASS** containers of any kind are permitted inside the fenced area of the pool or tennis courts.
- Members are expected to maintain a clean and attractive pool area. All trash and unconsumed food must be properly disposed in the provided receptacles.
- Spilled beverages and food must be cleaned off tables and the pool deck immediately.
- The PBRA Executive Board reserves the right to restrict consumption of food and beverages at any time.

POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) All guests must be accompanied by a current member and pay the associated guest fee(s). Children are not permitted to invite guest on their own. Groups in violation of this policy may be asked to leave. The actions of guest(s) will be reflected on the member with whom they are a guest of.
- 2) NEVER prop the gate open. This is a MAJOR safety violation and in doing so will result in your membership being revoked. Only the PBRA Executive Board may authorize the gate being open for events and will be monitored.
- 3) Parking is **PROHIBITED** on the street in front of the pool and tennis court area.
- 4) Running on the pool deck is prohibited.
- 5) Children under 16 years old must be accompanied by a current member 18 years or older.
- 6) Children 16 years old and older may swim unaccompanied by an adult during designated pool hours. Guests of anyone 16 years or younger are NOT permitted.
- 7) Proper Swimwear must be worn in the pool area. Cutoff shorts, undergarments, jeans or pants are not allowed. Additionally, attire with rips/tear, see-through fabrics and thong swimsuits are not permitted.
- 8) Swim diapers specially designed for infants and toddlers are **required for all children 3 and under**, even if they are potty trained and required regardless of age for anyone who is not fully potty trained. Disposable and cloth diapers are not allowed in the pool. Please dispose of all diapers in the containers **outside** of the pool enclosure.
- 9) No one should be on the rope in the deep end. If you or a family member or guest damages the rope, you will be assessed the cost of repair. This rope is required by the county at all times.
- 10) Animals are not permitted on the pool deck or in the pool.
- 11) No horseplay, running, dangerous/belligerent behavior and/or language. Let's all swim happy and play happy! ***If you violate this rule, you will be asked to leave.***
- 12) Gum is not permitted on the pool deck or tennis facilities.
- 13) If you use the grills, please clean up after yourself. These will last as long as we take care of them.

- 14) Outside food and beverages are allowed. Clean up after yourself (including trash, spills on the deck, etc.) Please don't leave trash for others. No glass containers. **Always make sure to clean up after yourselves.**
- 15) Always close umbrellas after usage to avoid damage. They are costly to replace and affect our budget.
- 16) Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the pool facilities. Smoking is permitted only outside the perimeter fence line in designated areas. You must dispose of your filters in appropriate trash containers.
- 17) Only pool floats are permitted in the pool, hard backed floats such as boogie boards or paddle boards are not permitted.
- 18) No one, except the lifeguard, is permitted on the guard chair at any time.
- 19) No bikes, skates, scooters, or skateboards, etc. are allowed inside the fenced area of the pool or on the tennis courts.
- 20) Emergency procedures must be observed. Swimmers must leave pool area immediately upon the signal or request of a PBRA Executive Board Member.
- 21) If you cannot see the bottom of the pool, **DO NOT SWIM!**
Never swim – or leave any of your guests, unattended.

DIVING BOARD RULES

- 1) Only 1 person is allowed on the diving board at a time.
- 2) A diver must wait until the preceding diver has surfaced and reached the ladder before diving.
- 3) No general swimming is permitted in the diving area, unless the diving board is closed by PBRA.
- 4) Diving board users must be able to swim to the ladder unassisted.
- 5) **NO fins** on the diving board.
- 6) Pool floats **are not** permitted in the diving well.

A member will be verbally warned for first offenses and rule violation; the patron will be asked to leave the pool facility if a second offense occurs. Revocation of membership will be left to the discretion of the Executive Board.

LOST AND FOUND

Any items found will be placed in the designated Lost and Found area. Items that are unclaimed may be discarded or donated without warning.

Tennis Rules and Regulations

GENERAL RULES

- 1) Courts are for the express purpose of playing or practicing tennis. Other uses of the courts must be requested and approved by the PBRA Executive Board.
- 2) Parking is **PROHIBITED** on the street in front of the tennis court area unless dropping off food and equipment.
- 3) No bikes, skates, scooters, or skateboards will be permitted on the tennis courts.
- 4) Courts are not to be used before 8:00 am. All play should be completed by 11:00 p.m.
- 5) Proper tennis etiquette must be observed at all times.
 - * Proper tennis shoes and tennis apparel must be worn while on the courts.
 - * Only players are allowed on the court. Those not playing tennis must remain outside the fence.
- 6) Players should not interrupt play or distract players on the other court for any reason including the following:
 - * Retrieving balls during play of a game
 - * Loud or continued talking or playing of music
 - * Entering or exiting the courts by walking behind other players.
- 7) Any of these rules may be changed or modified by the PBRA Executive Board.
- 8) Use of smoking and/or tobacco products must be in the designated areas only.
- 9) If you are the last person to leave the courts at night, please
 - * Turn off all court lights
 - * Turn off all bathroom lights
 - * Ensure all tennis gates and pool gates are locked securely.
 - * Please make sure all trash is disposed of properly.

COURT MAINTENANCE AND CLEAN-UP

- 1) Periodic maintenance and repairs may be required for the courts. Such time frames for maintenance will be designated on the reservation system. Players are to refrain from being on the courts during the entire maintenance period designated including the time when no maintenance personnel are on the courts (this allows the proper time for products like paint and caulk to dry and settle before play is resumed).
- 2) Each member and/or Captain of each member team must clean up the tennis courts, surrounding court area and bathrooms after each league play, practice or lesson. A large garbage can is located in the grandstand area of the courts. Empty all garbage cans on court into the supplied large can. If one is not near the courts, please secure one from the garbage can storage area next to the courts.
- 3) For safety purposes make sure all beverages, food containers and wrappers, tennis balls, tennis cans, and metal lids are disposed of properly after play.
- 4) If court maintenance is required outside of the typical clean-up, please report to

the PBRA Executive Board.

- 5) Glass bottles and containers are not allowed on the tennis courts.
- 6) Please lock the tennis court gates and pool gates, turn off the tennis court lights when done with matches, practice or leisure play.

A member will be verbally warned for first offenses and rule violation; the patron will be asked to leave the pool facility if a second offense occurs. Revocation of membership will be left to the discretion of the Executive Board.
